

## **DISABILITY WAIVER INFORMATION**

If, because of your disability, you can't learn English and/or the history and government questions, you can ask U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (CIS) for a waiver from these requirements.

People have received waivers for disabilities like strokes, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, brain injury and Alzheimer's. If CIS grants you the waiver, you won't have to answer the questions on English, history, or the government.

The Waiver is very difficult to get. It is ONLY for people with disabilities that make them unable to learn or remember new information. It is NOT for people who just have a hard time learning English or memorizing the history questions.

To get a disability-based waiver, you must have your doctor fill out Form N-648 (available online at <http://uscis.gov/graphics/formsfee/forms/index.htm>). The doctor must explain why you can't learn English or history and government.

***You or your doctor should consult with an immigration attorney so the form is completed satisfactorily.***

## **Renuncia a causa de Discapacidad**

Si, a causa de una discapacidad, usted no puede aprender Ingles y/o la historia o las preguntas sobre el gobierno puede pedir a U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (CIS) una Renuncia de estos requisitos.

Unos han recibido una renuncia de discapacidad por la apoplejía, el desorden de estrés-postraumático, una herida del cerebro, y la enfermedad de Alzheimer. Si CIS le concede la Renuncia no vas a tener que contestar las preguntas que se tratan del Ingles, la historia y tampoco el gobierno.

Es muy difícil obtener esta Renuncia. La Renuncia se aplica solamente a las personas con discapacidades específicas que se les hacen incapaz de aprender información nueva. NO SE APLICA a las personas que tienen dificultades con aprender el Ingles o las preguntas sobre la historia.

Para obtener una Renuncia por Discapacidad, su medico debe de llenar el formulario N-648 (disponible en la red informática (online) <http://uscis.gov/graphics/formsfee/forms/index.htm>). El medico debe de explicar porque usted no puede aprender el Ingles, sobre la historia y el gobierno.

***Ud. o su médico debe consultar con un abogado de inmigración para que se llene el formulario de modo satisfactorio.***
